

Flash card set Instructions:

- Beginner 2 Level:

There are two types of cards in this box. Divide them into two parts. In the first part, there will be cards with a picture on one side, and the corresponding name on the other side (cards with blue border). In the second part, there will be cards with either a picture or sentence (cards with pink border). Cards from the first part can be used to help students memorize Hindi names, spellings, and their English meanings.

1. Ask the child to tell the name of the pictures, and explain the name, if he can't tell it. Ask names from all of the cards. You can also divide the cards into two, three, and four letter words and use them at your own pace.
2. When the child has dully memorized all the words from the cards, ask him/her to write the words in Hindi. Practice with 10 cards daily, and give him points or stars.
3. You can also divide the cards from the second part into sentences with two, three, and four letter words. Spread all the cards on a table, and ask he child to make a correct pair with a picture and the corresponding sentence. This game will help the child to improve his Hindi comprehension and reading skills.
4. You can also set a time limit for these games. This way, the child will have more challenge and fun. You can also make more games from these cards according to the capacity of your child.
